## 2021 Scholarship(s) Available For High School Seniors in Greenbrier, Arkansas

The Greenbrier Area Arts Council will award scholarship(s) of up to \$500 to eligible high school seniors who attend Greenbrier High School.

Applicants must be graduating seniors, with a minimum 3.0 GPA, who are planning to attend a post-secondary institution in Arkansas and major in arts related or arts education fields such as music, visual art, graphic design, dance, vocal/choral studies, etc.

Completed applications with required attachments **must arrive by April 15, 2021.**

Successful applicant(s) will be notified by April 30, 2021.

## 2021 Scholarship Guidelines and Application Instructions For High School Seniors in Greenbrier, Arkansas

### Purpose:

To provide financial assistance for students seeking post-secondary education toward an arts-related career in fields such as visual or performing arts, music, graphic arts, drama, choral/vocal studies or arts/music education, etc.

### Guidelines:

- 1) Greenbrier Area Arts Council scholarship amounts are determined annually, not to exceed \$500 per award, and shall be granted to applicant(s) who have performed outstanding work in music, visual, vocal or performing arts.
- 2) The successful applicant(s) must be a graduating high school senior with a 3.0 or higher grade point average.
- 3) The applicant must be a resident of Faulkner County, Arkansas and attend Greenbrier High School.
- 4) Completed application forms must comply with all instructions listed below and on the form.
- 5) Completed application and required attachments must be **received by April 15, 2021**.
- 6) GAAC Scholarship Committee members will select the winner(s) from eligible applicants.
- 7) Successful applicant(s) will be notified by April 30.
- 8) The scholarship will be paid directly to an accredited Arkansas college or university, technology institute or training center. Funds provided by the scholarship must be used for tuition and/or required materials.
- 9) Scholarships must be used within one year of the award date. Failure to do so will result in forfeiture of the scholarship.
- 10) Successful applicant(s) are encouraged to give back to their community by donating time to help with the annual Art Jam festival which is the fund raiser for the scholarship.
- 11) GAAC asks that scholarship recipients share news on progress or honors by end of their first year.
- 12) Successful applicants will be recognized on GAAC's social media and websites for publicity purposes.

### Application Instructions:

- 2) Complete the application and attach a copy of your high school transcript, plus two letters of recommendation from a business or educational source.
- 3) Assure the transcript reflects academic work completed from grades 10, 11 and through the fall semester of grade 12.
- 4) Clarify your level of participation in activities as *Local, County, District, State or National*, when listing extracurricular school activities, community service projects, and leadership positions.
- 5) Attach additional pages to answer questions if needed. Do not include photos or news clippings.
- 6) Check your application carefully to assure all requested information has been provided.
